In a world filled with political unrest, violence, and back-alley intrigue, who and *what* is ultimately in charge of pulling the strings when the world's fate is at hand... and what are the consequences of those actions?

This is where “The Company” comes in; a bi-partisan, multi-national espionage entity that exists and operates in secret, outside the jurisdiction of the major world governments. Utilizing operatives who have undergone rigorous training while being completely phased out of society, The Company represents the interests of the most powerful people in the world. But at what point does The Company become too powerful, and who is there to stop them?

These are the major questions behind the motivations of the primary characters in ***Toy Guns***, a pensive but exciting action series that combines the stakes of ***24***, the jet-setting locales of ***The Bourne Identity***, and the conspiracy driven ideals of ***The X-Files***.

The story of Toy Guns begins with Harold “Harry” Stall, a former Company operative in his late forties who, after being secretly discharged, has led the life of a petty hitman in a depressed, alcoholic stupor. When the leader of The Company, Damien, brings him back in after a five year absence, Harry's first inclination is that he is finally being eliminated.

However, Damien, who is a shadowy and political figure within the organization, explains to Harry that a former operative named Will Rapelle, with whom Harry was partnered, has now gone rogue. Damien charges Harry with an ultimatum: find and kill Will Rapelle, or die. The one thing The Company doesn't know is that Will and Harry, while partnered, were also romantically involved with one another.

As Harry begins to follow Will's footsteps and track the clues left for him across the globe, a vast conspiracy begins to unravel regarding who is actually behind The Company's motives, and their ultimate goal for civilization.

After being accidentally paired by circumstance with aging beat cop Mike, each episode will involve Harry and Mike uncovering a further piece of the plot and protecting themselves from those that wish to keep these secrets hidden. As the story unfolds, viewers will begin to piece together the answer to the ultimate question of the series:

Who is really in charge of the world's future?
